- Mr. Heath - present


President Speakman announced this was a special meeting for the purpose of having a public hearing on a rezoning request that was filed by Wendell Crosier. Mr. Speakman announced the City Planning Commission had already followed all the procedures in the rezoning process, and the matter has been presented by the Commission to City Council, with a recommendation the rezoning be approved.

Ms. Colby, who is Chairwoman of the City Planning Commission, reported that the Planning Commission, after holding the required meetings and hearings, recommends the rezoning be approved.

Discussion followed. Ms. Colby then made a motion that City Council adopt the recommendation of the Planning Commission, and that the rezoning be approved. The motion was seconded by Mr. Heath. The motion carried unanimously by the five council members present.
