Jackson City Council Public Hearing August 24, 2015 6:30 P.M

A Public Hearing was held on August 24, 2015 at 6:30 p.m. in Jackson City Council Chambers. The meeting was called to order by President Ron Speakman. Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mr. Speakman.

Roll call was taken as follows:
