

ORDINANCE	NO.	18-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING REGULATION TEXT BY ADDING CHILD DAYCARE FACILITIES TO THE LIST OF CONITIONAL USES IN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Zoning Regulations as adopted do not list child daycare facilities as a conditional use in Industrial Districts:

WHEREAS, having daycare providers in an industrial zoned area provides employees of businesses in such zone with necessary daycare services;

WHEREAS, there is presently an effort being made to build a new daycare facility in an Industrial District which will provide the City of Jackson with a valuable service attractive to both employees and employers in the City and completion of the facility with the least amount of delay is necessary for the preservation of the health safety and welfare of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON THAT THE ZONING REGULATIONS BE AMENDED TO INCLUDE CHILD DAYCARE FACILITIES AS A CONDITIONAL USE IN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS AND THAT THE AMENDMENT BE REFLECTED IN THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, ZONING REGULATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, where in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
