THIS NOTICE IS A DETERMINATION OF AN INITIAL APPLICATION FOR UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS, ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 4141.28(D) & (E), OHIO REVISED CODE

The Ohio Department of Job and Family Services has ALLOWED the claimant's application for unemployment compensation benefits with a benefit year that begins 04/02/2006. During this one-year benefit period, the claimant's benefits rights are as follows:

The claimant was discharged by CITY OF JACKSON AUDITOR'S OFFICE on 03/23/2006. Facts establish that the employer discharged the claimant for a reason(s) not in connection with the work. Ohio's legal standard that determines if a discharge is without just cause is whether the claimant's acts, omissions, or course of conduct were such that an ordinary person would find the discharge not justifiable. After a review of the facts, this agency finds that the claimant was discharged without just cause under Section 4141.29(D)(2)(a) , Ohio Revised Code.
