## **ORDINANCE NO. 157-06**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 135-06 TO CORRECT A SCRIVENER'S ERROR AND TO SET FORTH THE CORRECT LINE ITEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 135-06 was adopted by Jackson City Council; and

WHEREAS, due to a scrivener's error the line item the contract is to be paid from was incorrect in Ordinance No. 135-06; and

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council now desires to amend Ordinance No. 135-06 to the extent to properly set forth the line item the contract is to be paid from.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

**Section One.** Jackson City Council directs that the payment of funds for the contract previously awarded to Hughes NATIONAL POWERX for the Veteran's Drive Substation and Lick Substation Equipment Procurement Project shall be paid from Line Item 731-7555-54005 – Utility Distribution System.

**Section Two.** The Mayor or the Safety Director is hereby authorized to execute this Contract and any financing documents according to the terms of the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

**Section Three.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to commence with the Veteran's Drive Substation and Lick Substation Equipment Procurement Project as soon as possible. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

**Section Four.** In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Five. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
