## ORDINANCE NO. 189-06

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

**Section One.** The original appropriation ordinance, as it relates to the General Fund is hereby modified so as to appropriate additional moneys as follows:

FUND	CATEGORY	AMOUNT	AMENDED APPROPRIATION
GENERAL FUND	110-7750-53007 (Professional Services)	\$ 7,635.00	\$ 64,458.56

**Section Two.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to modify the original appropriation ordinance and to appropriate additional funds necessary for the General Fund as soon as possible in order to address the pigeon problem in the downtown area. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

**Section Three.** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

We propose for a continued Pigeon feeding pan on top of several downtown buildings with whole corn. Once these pigeons begin to eat, in sufficient quantity, we will substitute this corn with a baited product - Avitrol; by name. The switch will be made later in the evening and the following morning all baited material will be removed. Dead pigeons, on site, will be picked up and disposed of in a manner consistent with label directions.

This method will continue for a period of one year; thus allowing us to achieve a 90% reduction of the current pigeon population.

Our technicians will be protected by the Ohio Workers Compensation, and our own General Comprehensive Liability Insurances.


