

ORDINANCE NO. 222-06

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ABOLISHMENT OF THE POSITION OF CHIEF OF STAFF.

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council has previously created the position of Chief of Staff, a position which is appointed by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council believes it is in the best interests of the City of Jackson to abolish the position of Chief of Staff, effective on January 1, 2008, which will coincide with and will be the commencement of the term of the Mayor which is to be elected in the November 2007 General Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The position of Chief of Staff is hereby abolished, effective as of January 1, 2008.

Section Two. This Ordinance shall go into effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Three. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
