

ORDINANCE NO. 223-06

AN ORDINANCE COMBINING THE POSITIONS OF SERVICE DIRECTOR AND SAFETY DIRECTOR INTO ONE POSITION, TO BE CALLED SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR, AND SETTING THE COMPENSATION FOR THE POSITION.

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council has previously separated the positions of Service Director and Safety Director into two separate positions, held by two separate persons; and

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council believes it is in the best interests of the City of Jackson to combine the position of Service Director and the position of Safety Director into one position to be called the Service-Safety Director, and that the compensation for the combined position be established; and

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council intends that this revising of the position be effective on January 1, 2008, which will coincide with and will be the commencement of the term of the Mayor which is to be elected in the November 2007 General Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The position of Service Director and the position of Safety Director are hereby combined into one full-time position, to be known as the Service-Safety Director. This shall take effect and be effective as of January 1, 2008.

Section Two. The position of Service-Safety Director shall receive an annual compensation of \$60,000.00, plus the benefits of health insurance as provided to other city employees, life insurance as provided to other city employees, and dental/vision insurance as provided to other city employees. The Service-Safety Director shall not be entitled to any overtime or comp time.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall go into effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
