ORDINANCE NO. 255-06

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND - MAYOR'S DEPARTMENT, AND AUTHORIZING THE JACKSON CITY AUDITOR TO MAKE PAYMENT TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services, Office of Unemployment Compensation (ODJFS), has made payments to Dennis Hodge (Hodge) in an amount of \$5,625.00 pursuant to his claim for unemployment compensation; and

WHEREAS, upon the Director's Redetermination said payments were found to be incorrect and payments to which Hodge was not entitled; and

WHEREAS, Hodge has appealed the Director's Redetermination; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson, the Employer (Jackson), has elected, pursuant to O.R.C. Section 4141.241 of the Ohio Revised Code, to make payments to the unemployment compensation fund in lieu of contributions; and

WHEREAS, under such circumstances, O.R.C. Section 4141.241(B), provides that Jackson shall be charged for the payments and if, thereafter, the Director of ODJFS collects the payment back from Hodge, pursuant to his duty under O.R.C. Section 4141.35, then the City's account at ODJFS will be credited with that amount in accordance with O.R.C. Section 4141.24(D); and

WHEREAS, Jackson has been informed by ODJFS that the said \$5,625.00 has been certified to the Attorney General of Ohio for collection from Hodge; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with Ohio law, the City Council of Jackson desires to appropriate the \$5,625.00, and authorize the Jackson City Auditor to make payment to ODJFS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The original appropriation ordinance, as it relates to the General Fund - Mayor's Department, is hereby modified so as to appropriate additional moneys as follows:

Section Two. The Jackson City Council is hereby authorized and directed to make the payment in an amount of \$5,625.00 to the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services as soon as this appropriation ordinance becomes effective.

Section Three. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to modify the appropriations as soon as possible in order to make the appropriate payment to ODJFS. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Four. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Five. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
