## ORDINANCE NO. 275-06

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A 2006 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUND, AND SETTING AND APPROVING APPROPRIATIONS IN THE 2006 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

**Section One.** There is hereby established the following fund:

**Section Two.** The original appropriation ordinance, as it relates to the 2006 Electric Improvement Fund is hereby modified so as to appropriate moneys as follows:

Section Three. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to establish this fund and make appropriations as soon as possible in order that work on this project can commence immediately and purchase orders can be created. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Four. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Five. In is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
