# ORDINANCE NO. 278-06

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN RECREATION FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The original appropriation ordinance, as it relates to the recreation fund, is hereby modified so as to appropriate additional money follows:

FUND	CATEGORY	AMOUNT	AMENDED APPROPRIATION
RECREATION FUND	760-7320-56001 (TRANSFER - OUT)	\$200,000.00	\$200,000.00

Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to modify the appropriation ordinance and to appropriate the additional funds necessary for the RECREATION FUND to record transfers out to the bike path fund as soon as possible before the year end. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
