

ORDINANCE NO. 287-06

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING REDUCTIONS IN APPROPRIATIONS IN THE 2006 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPROVEMENT FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The original appropriation ordinance, as it relates to the 2006 Community Housing Improvement Fund is hereby modified so as to reduce appropriations as follows:

Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to modify the appropriations as soon as possible in order to properly reflect the 2006 Community Housing Improvements Fund appropriations in the Auditor's records for year end accounting purposes. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. If the Council cannot be convened to report, then for passage of this Ordinance to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed out with an emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
