ORDINANCE NO. 311-06

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE GENERAL FUND - GENERAL GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCE, OF THE CITY OF TACKSON, STATE OF ORIO, as follows.

<u>Section One.</u> The original appropriation ordinance, as it relates to the General Fund – General Government Department is hereby modified so as to appropriate additional moneys as follows:

Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to modify the appropriations as soon as possible in order to advance funds to the 2006 Community Housing Improvement Fund and the Park Enhancement Fund so that the said funds will have a zero cash balance at the end of the year, and in order that the City Auditor can properly make the postings on the 2006 records. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Three.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
