

ORDINANCE NO. 314-06

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING REDUCTION OF APPROPRIATIONS IN
PARK ENHANCEMENT FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE
OF OHIO, as follows

Section One. The original appropriation ordinance, as it relates to the various funds listed below, is hereby modified so as to reduce appropriations as follows:

FUND	CATEGORY	AMOUNT	AMENDED APPROPRIATION
PARK ENHANCEMENT FUND	438-7312-53064 (PROJECT EXPENSE)	(\$4,877.14)	\$30,095.86

Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to modify the appropriation ordinance and to reduce appropriations as necessary for the PARK ENHANCEMENT FUND as project expenses will not meet current appropriations. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four, _____ Secretary found and determined that all formal actions of this Council resulting in the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
