

ORDINANCE NO. 315-06

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR JANUARY 1, 2007 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2007, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. City funds are hereby appropriated for the period of January 1, 2007 through March 31, 2007, as set forth in exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary adopt a temporary appropriation ordinance for the year 2007 as soon as possible. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
