ORDINANCE NO. 68-07

AN ORDINANCE FINDING THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE AND RESPONSIVE BID, AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE CITY OF JACKSON STREET PAVING PROJECT TO COX PAVING, INC., 11741 STATE ROUTE 72, LEESBURG, OHIO 45135, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. Council finds that Cox Paving, Inc., 11741 State Route 72, Leesburg, Ohio 45135, is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the City of Jackson Street Paving Project. This contract has been lawfully advertised and bid, and the lowest responsive and responsible bids is in an amount of One Hundred Nineteen Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-nine and 75/100 Dollars (\$119,839.75). Funds for this project shall be paid from the Community Improvement Fund, line item 228-7625-54004 (Streets, Highways & Sidewalks).

Section Two. The Mayor or the Safety Director is hereby authorized to execute this Contract and any financing documents according to the terms of the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Section Three. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to approve the street paving project as soon as possible in order that the paving may commence in a quick and timely manner. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Four. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Five. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
