ORDMANCE NO. 01-07

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 214-06, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council previously passed Ordinance No. 214-06, which transferred appropriations concerning the Bike Path Project; and

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council now desires to repeal Ordinance No. 214-06 in order to undo the accounting entry authorized by such ordinance, and thereby being able to close the books for the year 2006.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON. STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. Ordinance No. 214-06 is hereby repealed, and the City Auditor is authorized to undo the entry which resulted from Ordinance No. 214-06.

<u>Section Two.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to repeal Ordinance No. 214-06 in order to undo the accounting entry, and thereby close the books for the year 2006. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Three.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

<u>Section Four.</u> In is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

This Ordinance shall go into effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
