ORDINANCE NO. 02-07

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PERSONAL LEAVE/TIME OFF FOR THE POLICE CHIEF AND ASSISTANT POLICE CHIEF.

WHEREAS, with the exception of the position of Chief of Police and Assistant Chief of Police, City employees are entitled to receive up to 40 hours per year for personal leave/time off; and

WHEREAS, the position of Chief of Police and Assistant Chief of Police, City employees are currently entitled to receive only 32 hours per year for personal leave/time off; and

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council desires to increase the personal leave/time off for the positions of Chief of Police and Assistant Chief of Police so that these positions will receive the same personal leave/time off as other employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1. The personal leave/time off for the positions of Chief of Police and Assistant Chief of Police shall be 40 hours per year, effective January 1, 2007.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall go into effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
