ORDINANCE NO. 33-07

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE ELECTRIC FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

The original appropriation ordinance, as it relates to the Electric Fund, is Section One. hereby modified so as to appropriate additional moneys as follows:

Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to modify the appropriations as soon as possible in that this item was inadvertently left out in the preparation of the permanent budget, and the moneys need to be appropriated to assure that refunds to customers can be processed in a timely manner. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails Section Three. to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
