## **ORDINANCE NO. 60-07**

AN ORDINANCE FINDING THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE AND RESPONSIVE BID, AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR FUEL FOR THE CITY'S VEHICLES, TO SSC STORES, INC., dba THE FILLING STATION AND QUICKSTOP, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

<u>Section One.</u> Council finds that ssc Stores, Inc., dba the Filling Station and Quickstop, fuel providing facilities located in the City of Jackson, Ohio, is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the supply of fuel for the City's vehicles and equipment. This contract has been lawfully advertised and bid, and the lowest responsive and responsible bid is as follows:

- o \$ 0.05 off per gallon on the posted gas and diesel prices
- \$ 0.10 off per gallon on the posted price of kerosene. Kerosene shall be available at the Quickstop and Handimart.
- o The City shall be billed monthly.
- The Filling Station and Quickstop are open 24 hours per day, seven days per week.

The City reserves the right to purchase fuel at alternate locations if prices are lower at another location, and in times of emergency.

<u>Section Two.</u> The Mayor or the Service Director is hereby authorized to execute this Contract according to the terms of the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

<u>Section Three.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to have a fuel supplier available to provide fuel for the City's fleet. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Four.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance

shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

<u>Section Five.</u> This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
