ORDINANCE NO. 61-07

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, AND RUMPKKE OF OHIO, INC., FOR LANDFILL SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson collects waste from customers in the City of Jackson, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Rumpke of Ohio, Inc. (Rumpke) has a landfill facility where waste may be disposed of; and

WHEREAS, the City and Rumpke desire to enter into an Agreement relating to landfill services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The Mayor and/or City Council President is authorized to enter into an Agreement between the City of Jackson, Ohio, and Rumpke of Ohio, Inc., to provide landfill services for the City's trash collection. A copy of the Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A". The cost of this contract shall be paid from line item 721-7540-53002 (Contractual Services).

Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to enter into this agreement as soon as possible to assure that waste collected by the City of Jackson may be properly disposed of at a landfill facility. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions, were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
