ORDINANCE NO. 120-07

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH NORTHCOAST PRODUCTS, P.O. BOX 177, LEBANON, OHIO 45036, FOR A 1,000 GALLON TANK FOR THE DURA PATCH MACHINE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. Council hereby authorizes the City to enter into a Lease Agreement with Northcoast Products, P.O. Box 177, Lebanon, Ohio 45036, for the lease of a 1,000 gallon tank for the Dura-Patch machine. The purchase of a Dura-Patch Machine from Leader Machinery Company, Ltd., P.O. Box 177, Lebanon, Ohio 45036. The lease shall be in an amount of \$300.00 per month.

Section Two. The Mayor and/or his designated representative is hereby authorized to execute a Lease Agreement.

Section Three. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to lease the tank in order to operate the Dura Patch Machine. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Four. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Five. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
