## ORDINANCE NO. 07-08

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, AND THE OHIO ASSOCIATION OF PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEES, OAPSE/AFSCME LOCAL 4/AFL-CIO AND ITS LOCAL #410, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City and The Ohio Association of Public School Employees, OAPSE/AFSCME Local 4/AFL-CIO and its Local #410 (OAPSE), had previously entered into negotiations and reached a tentative agreement, which was presented to Jackson City Council but was not approved by Jackson City Council at that time; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into subsequent negotiations and as a result have modified the original agreement and the parties now desire to present the renegotiated Agreement to City Council for consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

<u>Section One.</u> The Agreement between The Ohio Association of Public School Employees, OAPSE/AFSCME Local 4/AFL-CIO and its Local #410, and the City of Jackson, Ohio, a copy of which is attached hereto, is hereby approved. The Mayor is authorized to enter into this Agreement as soon as possible.

<u>Section Two.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to enter into this agreement as soon as possible in order to meet statutory timelines. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Three.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those
formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
