ORDINANCE NO. 16-08

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO APPROVE THE REQUISITION COSTS FOR A HOME THROUGH THE CHIP PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has previously approved the CHIP Program, a program designed and utilized for construction and rehabilitation of qualified homes within the City of Jackson, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated there will be construction costs for a home at 172 Huron Street, and it is anticipated the construction costs will be \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, in order to proceed with this project funds will be required to be moved to the banking account to cover the expenses associated with this project; and

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council desires to authorize the Service Director to approve the requisition of this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The Jackson City Service Director is hereby authorized to approve the requisition for the construction costs associated with the CHIP Program, and for the home to be located at 172 Huron Street, Jackson, Ohio.

Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to authorize this action as soon as possible so this project can commence and proceed in a timely manner. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four.

In is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
