ORDINANCE NO. 21-08

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FUND, APPROPRIATING MONEYS FOR SAID FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The following fund is hereby established:

Section Two. The temporary appropriation ordinance, as it relates to the Continuing Professional Development Fund, is hereby modified as follows:

Section Three. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to establish this fund and make appropriations in this fund as soon as possible as the City has received revenue for this Fund and the revenue needs to be posted in the proper fund as soon as possible. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Four. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Five.

This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.


