## **ORDINANCE NO. 38-08**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING JACKSON CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 355.01, RELATING TO OFF-STREET PARKING – MUNICIPAL LOTS, AND JACKSON CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 355.99, RELATING TO OFF-STREET PARKING - PENALTY.

Section One. The Jackson Codified Ordinance Sections 355.01 and 335.99 are hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit "A".

## EXHIBIT A

## 355.01 **MUNICIPAL LOTS.**

- (a) One municipal parking lot is established in the City, being the lot between Broadway Street and Portsmouth Street, behind the businesses formerly known as Wood Furniture, and prior to that G.C. Murphy.
- (b) Each parking space in the municipal parking lot shall be available for the public to use. There shall be no charge for parking in the municipal parking lot, and the parking shall be limited to no more than \_\_\_\_ consecutive hours. Public parking shall be available to the public throughout the year, except for the week of the Jackson County Apple Festival, being the Saturday before the festival through the following Saturday. During the week of the Apple Festival the Jackson Fire Department shall have control of the municipal parking lot, and may lease the parking spaces on the lot to raise funds for the Fire Department.

## **355.99 PENALTY.**

- (a) Whoever parks in the municipal parking for longer than \_\_\_\_ consecutive hours, or whoever parks in the municipal parking lot during the week of the Jackson County Apple Festival without proper permission, shall be subject to the penalties as set forth in Section 303.99.
- (b) Any vehicle found illegally parking in the municipal parking lot may be seized and towed to a place of safekeeping. Such motor vehicle shall be released to the owner only after all the owner's parking violation penalty and all towing charge, are paid.
