ORDINANCE NO. 46-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING JACKSON CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 945.073 RELATING TO GARBAGE – NO FRANCHISE FEE REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN SERVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The Jackson Codified Ordinance Section 945.073 is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section Two. The Clerk of Council shall assure that this Ordinance is posted in all the City's Ordinance books.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.

EXHIBIT "A"

945.073 NO FRANCHISE FEE REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN SERVICES.

The City may issue a franchise, as needed and as the City deems necessary, to providers of services for medical waste disposal, commercial compactors, and recycle dumpsters. No franchise fee shall be required of any provider of services for medical waste disposal, commercial compactors, and recycle dumpsters.

Franchises issued for services for medical waste disposal, commercial compactors, and recycle dumpsters under this section shall not be subject to the requirements of Section 945.071.

The franchisee providing services for medical waste disposal, commercial compactors, and recycle dumpsters under this section shall be subject to the client list reporting requirements set forth in Codified Ordinance Section 945.072.

A franchise fee shall be required for all other services, including but not limited to roll-offs and temporary clean-up containers.
