SPONSOR: EBrown (C Brown) ORDINANCE NO. 46-08

AN ORDINANCE FINDING THE HIGHEST RESPONSIBLE AND RESPONSIVE BID, AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE SALE OF REAL PROPERTY TO THE LIBERTY TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. Council finds that the Liberty Township Board of Trustees is the highest responsive and responsible bidder for the purchase of City owned real property which is no longer needed for municipal purposes. This sale of real property has been lawfully advertised and bid, and the highest responsive and responsible bid is in the amount of One Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$100.00). The property may be used for cemetery purposes only.

Section Two. The Mayor or the Service Director is hereby authorized to execute a deed transferring the real property according to the terms of the highest responsive and responsible bid.

Section Three. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to accept this bid as soon as possible, and to transfer the real property so it may be used by the Township for cemetery purposes. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Four. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Five. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
