## ORDINANCE NO. 76-08

AN ORDINANCE FINDING THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE AND RESPONSIVE BID, AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR MEMORIAL BUILDING ROOF REPLACEMENT CONTRACT INSULATED ROOFING CONTRACTORS, 10801 PLANTSIDE DRIVE, LOUISVILLE, KENTUCKY 40299, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. Council finds that Insulated Roofing Contractors, 10801 Plantside Drive, Louisville, Kentucky 40299, is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the Memorial Building Roof Replacement Contract. This contract has been lawfully advertised and bid, and the lowest responsive and responsible bid is in the amount of Eighty Thousand Three Hundred Eighty and 00/100 Dollars (\$80,380.00). This contract shall be paid from line item 110-7750-54003 – General Fund: General Government (Buildings & Other Structures.

<u>Section Two.</u> The Mayor or the Service Director is hereby authorized to execute this Contract and any financing documents according to the terms of the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

<u>Section Three.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to accept this bid as soon as possible to receive the bid price, and in order to commence with this project as soon as possible to meet pending timelines. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Four.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Five. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.

Dear Mr. Sheward:

After personally reviewing the City of Jackson Memorial Building roof and discussing the conditions with some of my colleagues that have decades of experience with both new and re roof foam projects, I have decided to submit the following proposal additions to the architect's project manual per his approval.

The upper roof appears to be in generally good condition. IRC will infrared scan existing upper roof. Tear out wet foam and replace wet areas with fresh foam and recoat with 30 mills of silicone and granules.

The barrel roof is pitted badly. IRC will tear off down to built up roof and install brand new foam roof per specs at 1 1/2" thick and apply 30 mills silicone and granules. Essentially, the City of Jackson will have a brand new roof in the large barrel section, with the entire building issued a leak free, non-prorated 10 year warranty.
