ORDINANCE NO. 79-08

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 19-01, SECTION FOUR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 19-01, adopted on April 23, 2001, set forth in Section Four that a Thirty Five percent (35%) rebate on a customer's bill on the electric usage that includes December electric usage for the year 2002, and thereafter until such time as that may be changed by Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to eliminate the rebate, and Jackson City Council now desires to eliminate the Thirty Five percent (35%) rebate on a customer's bill on the electric usage that includes December, to be effective immediately.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. Ordinance No. 19-01, Section Four, is hereby repealed and vacated, and Thirty Five percent (35%) rebate on a customer's bill on the electric usage that includes December electric usage for the year 2002, and thereafter is hereby eliminated, effective immediately. All other Sections of Ordinance No. 19-01 shall remain in full force and effect.


Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to eliminate the rebate to meet the costs of operating the City's electric utility. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four.

In is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


