**ORDINANCE NO. 81-08**

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE WATER FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

**Section One.** The appropriation ordinance, as it relates to the Water Fund is hereby modified so as to appropriate additional moneys as follows:

FUND	CATEGORY	AMOUNT	AMENDED APPROPRIATION
WATER FUND	701-7510-52010 (Salaries & Wages)	\$ 60,000.00	\$ 285,693.55
WATER FUND	701-7510-52011 (P.E.R.S.)	\$ 8,500.00	\$ 40,097.10
WATER FUND	701-7510-52012 (Health Insurance)	\$ 40,000.00	\$ 85,000.00
WATER FUND	701-7510-52020 (Medicare)	\$ 4,500.00	\$ 8,280.87

**Section Two.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to approve this additional appropriation in order that personal service expenses can be timely paid as incurred and in accordance with union contractual obligations. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

**Section Three.** In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

**Section Four.**

In is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



# MEMO

RE: Ordinance Request

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Our office has received a request to forward the appropriate paperwork to Jack Detty to prepare an Ordinance for the next City Council Meeting for additional appropriations as follows:

701-7510-52010	Water Fund: Salaries & Wages	\$60,000.00
701-7510-52011	Water Fund: P.E.R.S.	\$8,500.00
701-7510-52012	Water Fund: Health Insurance	\$4,000.00
701-7510-52020	Water Fund: Medicare	\$4,500.00

These additional appropriations are necessary to adjust the amounts budgeted for personal services. These figures were estimates when the permanent budget was being prepared at the beginning of the year since contracts weren't completely settled and insurance premiums weren't known at the time the budget was prepared. Rather than go back and re-work the entire budget document before it was adopted, it was indicated to Council that revisions to personal services would probably be necessary later on in the year when the actual numbers would be known.

This should be considered an emergency so that personal service expenses can be paid timely as incurred and as per union contractual agreements.
