ORDINANCE NO. 6-09

AN ORDINANCE FINDING THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE AND RESPONSIVE BID, PENDING APPROVAL OF THE OPWC REQUIREMENTS, AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE ROUTE 93 WATERLINE PROJECT TO MIKE ENYART & SONS, INC., 408 SOLIDA ROAD, SOUTH POINT, OHIO 45680, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. Council finds that Mike Enyart & Sons, Inc., 408 Solida Road, South Point, Ohio 45680, is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the Route 93 Waterline Replacement Contract. This contract has been lawfully advertised and bid, and the lowest responsive and responsible bid is in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Three Thousand Four Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$253,400.). This contract shall not be executed until the completion of all requirements of the OPWC Agreement between the City and OPWC has been fulfilled to the satisfaction of OPWC. When executed this contract shall be paid from line item 228-7Utility Distribution Systems.

Section Two. This contract shall not be awarded and shall not be executed until the completion of all requirements of the OPWC Agreement between the City and OPWC has been fulfilled to the satisfaction of OPWC.

Section Three. The Mayor or the Service Director is hereby authorized to execute this Contract and any financing documents according to the terms of the lowest responsive and responsible bid.


Section Four. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to accept this bid as soon as possible to receive the bid price, and in order to execute the contract immediately upon the satisfaction of the requirements of OPWC concerning this project. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Five. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Six.

This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.


