ORDINANCE NO. 81-09

AN ORDINANCE TO MOVE APPROPRIATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 79-09 was duly enacted and adopted by this Council on September 14, 2009; and

WHEREAS, it was discovered after passage that Ordinance 79-09 contained numerous scrivener's errors that need to be corrected; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is intended to correct the scrivener's errors contained in the original Ordinance 79-09, and in no way changes the basic movement of appropriations which was approved by the passage of Ordinance 79-09.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One.

City appropriations are hereby moved as follows:

Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to approve the moving of these appropriations in order that personal services for the remainder of the year in the Administrative Services Department may be funded. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four.

In is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
