ORDINANCE NO. 90-09

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FUND NO. 409 – WATER PLANT DEWATERING PROJECT FUND, AND SETTING AND APPROVING APPROPRIATIONS IN THE WATER PLANT DEWATERING PROJECT FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. There is hereby established the following fund:

409 WATER PLANT DEWATERING PROJECT FUND

Section Two. The original appropriation ordinance, as it relates to the Water Plant Dewatering Project Fund is hereby modified so as to appropriate moneys as follows:

Section Three. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that the City has received revenue for this Fund and the moneys need to be posted in the proper fund as soon as possible. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Four. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Five. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
