ORDINANCE NO. 101-09

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE WATER FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

*Section One.* The appropriation ordinance, as it relates to the Water Fund is hereby modified so as to appropriate additional moneys as follows:

WATER FUND	701-7510-52012 (Health Insurance)	\$ 7,345.00	\$ 59,780.48


*Section Two.* This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to approve this additional appropriation in order that the appropriations can be put in place and wages and health insurance can be timely paid. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

*Section Three.* In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four.

In is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



Our office has received a request to forward the appropriate paperwork to Jack Delty to prepare an Ordinance for the next City Council Meeting for additional appropriations as follows:

701-7510-52010	Water Fund: Salaries & Wages	\$14,000.00
701-7510-52012	Water Fund: Health Insurance	\$7,345.00

These additional appropriations are needed to pay salaries & wages and health insurance premiums for the remainder of the year. These two line items ran short due to standby pay and step up pay received by employees that wasn't factored into the permanent budget and for changes that were made in health insurance policies during the year that weren't factored into the budget.

This should be considered an emergency so that wages and health insurance premiums can be paid timely.
