## ORDINANCE NO. 108-09

AN ORDINANCE TO MODIFY ELECTRIC RATES FOR THE MONTHS OF DECEMBER 2009 THROUGH MARCH 2010, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

<u>Section One.</u> For the period from December 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010, the electric rates for Domestic, Commercial, and Electric Home consumers shall reduced by an amount of \$.0075 per kwh. This temporary reduction shall be a reduction of \$.0075 per kwh as set forth in Jackson Codified Ordinances 921.06(a), (b), and (c).

**Section Two.** For the period from December 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010, the electric rates for Industrial consumers shall reduced by an amount of \$.0075 on the Energy Charge per kwh as set forth in Jackson Codified Ordinances 921.07(a).

<u>Section Three.</u> On April 1, 2010 the rate reduction shall terminate and the electric rates for Domestic, Commercial, and Electric Home consumers and for Industrial consumers shall return to the rates as currently established in Jackson Codified Ordinances 921.06(a), (b), and (c) and Jackson Codified Ordinances 921.07(a).

<u>Section Four.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to adopt this temporary rate reduction immediately in order that it may take effect on December 1, 2009. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Five.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
