ORDINANCE NO. 24-10

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE POSITION OF SWIMMING POOL MANAGER, CREATING THE POSITIONS OF POOL MANAGER/LIFEGUARD AND CO-POOL MANAGER/CONCESSIONS COORDINATOR/LIFEGUARD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

<u>Section One.</u> The position of Swimming Pool Manager is hereby abolished and eliminated.

Section Two. There is hereby created the following positions within the City, Municipal Swimming Pool:

- Pool Manager/Lifeguard
- Co-Pool Manager/Concessions Coordinator/Lifeguard

Each of these positions shall be seasonal positions. Each position shall be appointed by the Mayor, shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor, and shall report to the Mayor or his designate. Pay for each of these positions shall be \$ 9.25 per hour. The persons serving in the positions of Pool Manager/Lifeguard and Co-Pool Manager/Concessions Coordinator/Lifeguard shall not be entitled to receive health insurance or any other benefits, and shall receive only those benefits set forth and required by the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Three. This Ordinance is hereby is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the further reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective in order to have necessary personnel in place at the opening date of the City's Municipal Swimming Pool. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Four.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

<u>Section Five.</u> This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
