ORDINANCE NO. 94-10

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE JACKSON CITY AUDITOR TO MAKE REIMBURSEMENTS FROM THE RAILROAD FUND FOR THE YEAR 2009 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MAXXIMUS COST ALLOCATION STUDY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson has previously hired Maximus to conduct a Cost Allocation Study within the City of Jackson; and

WHEREAS, Maximus has completed the assessment study and has made recommendations as to reimbursements in certain City funds; and

WHEREAS, Jackson City Council desires to adopt the assessment study and authorize the City Auditor to make the reimbursements in accordance with the assessment study.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The Jackson City Auditor is hereby authorized to make reimbursements for the year 2009 in accordance with the Maximus Cost Allocation Study, as follows:



Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, and for the further reason that it is necessary to be posted for accounting purposes as soon as possible. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.


