### ORDINANCE NO. 131-10

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE REPAYMENT OF THE ADVANCEMENT OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY MADE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

**Section One.** There is hereby authorized the repayment of funds from the Storm Water Utility Fund as follows:

ADVANCES OUT	AMOUNT	ADVANCES IN	AMOUNT
STORM WATER UTILITY 740-7529-56010	(\$ 388,942.41) (Advances Out)	GENERAL FUND 110--0900-40915	\$ 388,942.41 (Advances In)

This is to partially repay the advance that the General Fund made to the Storm Water Utility Fund at the end of 2009.

**Section Three.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to show accurate fund balances for bookkeeping purposes. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

**Section Three.** In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

**Section Four.** In is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
