## ORDINANCE NO. 6-10

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO EXTEND CONTRACT CONCERNING THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, AND F.O.P. OHIO LABOR COUNCIL, INC., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson, Ohio (City) and the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. (F.O.P.), entered into a collective bargaining agreement which was to expire on September 21, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the City and F.O.P. desire to extend the current collective bargaining agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

**Section One.** The Council of the City of Jackson, Ohio hereby authorizes the Collective Bargaining Agreement between City of Jackson, Ohio (City) and the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc., which was to expire on September 21, 2009, be extended and remain in full force and effect and that all wages, hours, and terms and conditions of said Collective Bargaining Agreement shall remain in full force and effect with no changes or modifications through September 21, 2011. On September 21, 2011, the collective Bargaining Agreement shall remain in full force and effect until a successor contract is reached or implemented. A copy of the Agreement to Extend Contract is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and is made a part hereof, and said Agreement to Extend Contract is hereby authorized and ratified by the Jackson City Council.

**Section Two.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to enter into this agreement as soon as possible to resolve contractual issues between the parties and to meet guidelines as set forth by the Ohio Revised Code. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.


**Section Three.** In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

**Section Four.**

This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.
