ORDINANCE NO. 79-10

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN VARIOUS FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

<u>Section One.</u> The appropriation ordinance, as it relates to the General Fund, the Cemetery Tax Levy Fund, the Fire Tax Levy Fund, and the Fire Tax Levy 1995 Fund, is hereby modified so as to appropriate additional moneys as follows:

<u>Section Two.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, in that it is necessary to approve these additional appropriations in that the appropriations can be in place and the expenses can be placed upon the books accordingly. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

<u>Section Three.</u> In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open
