ORDINANCE NO. 48-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO TO ACCEPT THE BID OF WESCO DISTRIBUTION, INC. FOR PURCHASE OF A 15kV CONDUCTOR FOR THE LICK SUBSTATION FOR THE CITY OF JACKSON AS IT WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in response to a request for bids for a 15kV conductor for the City of Jackson's Lick sub-station, bids have been reviewed and a determination has been made as to the lowest and best responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the lowest and best responsive bid was from Wesco Distribution, Inc. of Aurora, Ohio for a 15kV conductor for a cost of \$62,510.40 plus a maximum additional cost of \$4,375.79 for a potential price escalation due to the volatility of the copper market for a total maximum cost of \$66,886.19; and

WHEREAS, the immediate passage of this ordinance constitutes an emergency as delay will cause an increase in price due to the volatility in the copper market and the completion of the project for less than the maximum cost is necessary for the preservation of the public's health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the Mayor or Director of Service and Public Safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio to accept the bid submitted by Wesco Distribution, Inc. for a maximum cost of \$66,886.19.

Section 2. This matter is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
