## ORDINANCE NO. 68-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO TO ACCEPT THE BID OF RICART FORD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$81,044.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2012 CLASS FIVE TRUCK WITH SERVICE BODY AND CRANE AS IT WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in response to a request for bids for a 2012 class five truck with service body and crane for the City of Jackson, bids have been reviewed and a determination has been made as to the lowest and best responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the lowest and best responsive bid was from Ricart Ford, 4255 S. Hamilton Rd., Columbus, Ohio, for a cost not to exceed \$81,044 and to be paid from line item number 711-7525-54006; and

WHEREAS, the immediate passage of this ordinance constitutes an emergency as the purchase must be completed immediately in order receive the truck at the bid price and to begin immediate use which is necessary for the preservation of the public's health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:


**Section 1.** The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the Mayor or Director of Service and Public Safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio to accept the bid submitted by Ricart Ford for a maximum cost of \$81,044.

**Section 2.** This matter is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio.

**Section 3.** In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
