ORDINANCE NO.06-12

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REVISING ORDINANCE 81-11 WHICH AMENDED SECTION 945.04 OF THE CITY OF JACKSON CODE OF ORDINANCES SO AS TO CORRECT A CLERICAL ERROR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 81-11 of the City of Jackson was recently enacted to set the rates for garbage collection; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 81-11 included a language from prior legislation which had previously been repealed and the correct version of the amended Section 945.04 as intended by the legislation is set forth below; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT ORDINANCE 81-11 IS REPEALED AND AMENDED SO THAT THE FOLLOWING BE AN ORDINANCE GOVERNING GARBAGE COLLECTION RATES WITH THOSE UNDERLINED PORTIONS SHOWING THE AMENDMENTS TO THE ORIGINAL LANGUAGE AND THAT IT BE NUMBERED AS SECTION 945.04 AND REPLACED WITHIN THE JACKSON CITY CODE, IN REGULAR TEXT, AS FOLLOWS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

945.04 COLLECTION RATES FOR BUSINESSES.

(a) The following monthly charges shall be made against each and every operator of a business, commercial or industrial operation, who avails himself of the garbage and refuse collection, removal and disposition service, one pick-up per week, provided for his benefit by the City:

Business garbage collection service to manufacturers, supermarkets, grocery stores and any business not previously mentioned shall be negotiated by the Service-Safety Director at rates consistent with those listed above. The Service-Safety Director shall also negotiate rates for collection service to a customer for

pick-up more frequently than once a week. These negotiated rates shall be reviewed periodically by Council or by a committee of Council.

(b) The charges in subsection (a) hereof are based upon weekly pick-up services. For each additional pick-up service, if desired, the charge will be arrived at by negotiating with the Service-Safety Director.


(c) The Director is hereby authorized and directed to determine and fix fees for parties or firms, not above mentioned, based upon the cost of service provided.

(d) Each and every operator of a business, commercial or industrial operation who avails himself of the garbage and refuse collection shall pay such collection rate on or before the due date of each month or a delinquency charge of ten percent (10%) shall be added to such account for failure to pay the account on or before the due date of each month.

(e) The garbage and refuse collection, removal and disposition services provided for the benefit of every operator of a business, commercial or industrial operation, whether inside or outside the City, who avails himself of the garbage and refuse collection, removal and disposition service, shall be for garbage and refuse generated on the business, commercial or industrial operation premises only and in no event shall the garbage and refuse picked up at business, commercial or industrial operation include garbage and refuse which was generated at a site other than that of the premises of the business, commercial or industrial operation.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
