ORDINANCE NO. 21-12

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING A BLANKET PURCHASE ORDER LIMITED TO AMOUNTS OF \$2,500.00, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CITY AUDITOR.

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City has determined it to be beneficial to the City to approve the use of blanket purchase orders limited to a dollar amount of \$2,500.00 and must be identified as "Blanket Purchase Order".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON THAT THE USE OF BLANKET PURCHASE ORDERS ARE PERMITTED PROVIDED THE AMOUNT DOES NOT EXCEED \$2,500 AND THAT THE ORDER BE IDENTIFIED AS "BLANKET PURCHASE ORDER".

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
