ORDINANCE NO. 22-12

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 18-12 AND, THEREBY, LEAVING UNCHANGED THAT PRIOR LEGISLATION THAT IS CODIFIED IN SECTION 927.05 (ORD. 142-03) OF THE CITY OF JACKSON CODE OF ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson finds it prudent and necessary to repeal Ordinance 18-12 which created an increase in the City sewer rates; and

WHEREAS, the legislative authority of the City of Jackson further finds that matters relating to funding of the City sewer system constitute an emergency and that it is necessary that this repeal be effective immediately as it is required for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO THAT ORDINANCE 18-12 BE, AND HEREBY IS, REPEALED AND THAT THE PRIOR LEGISLATION THAT IS CODIFIED IN SECTION 927.05 OF THE CITY OF JACKSON CODE OF ORDINANCES BE UNCHANGED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and the deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
