ORDINANCE NO. 27-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO TO ACCEPT THE BID OF BELL EQUIPMENT COMPANY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$199,400.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 25 CUBIC YARD PACKER TRUCK AS IT WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED, ~~AND DECLARING EMERGENCY.~~

WHEREAS, in response to a request for bids for a 25 cubic yard packer truck for the City of Jackson for use in the garbage department, bids have been reviewed and a determination has been made as to the lowest and best responsive bid; and


WHEREAS, it has been determined that the lowest and best responsive bid was from Bell Equipment Company, 78 Northpointe Dr., Lake Orion, MI, for a cost not to exceed \$199,400 and to be paid from line item number 721-7540-54002; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the Mayor or Director of Service and Public Safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio to accept the bid submitted by Bell Equipment Company for a maximum cost of \$199,400 and to execute those documents necessary for the purchase of the packer truck.

Section 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
