ORDINANCE NO. 40-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO TO ACCEPT THE PROPOSAL OF CT CONSULTANTS TO PROVIDE ENGINEERING SERVICES AND TO PREPARE BIDDING AND CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS FOR BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS ON HARDING AVENUE AS IT WAS THE LOWEST AND BEST RESPONSIVE PROPOSAL SUBMITTED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in response to a request for proposals for engineering services for the City of Jackson, proposals have been reviewed and a determination has been made as to the lowest and best responsive proposal for professional engineering services to prepare bidding and construction documents for bridge improvements on Harding Avenue in the City of Jackson; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the lowest and best responsive proposal for the requested engineering services was from CT Consultants of Columbus, Ohio for an amount not to exceed \$171,000.00.; and

WHEREAS, the completion of the improvements to the Harding Avenue bridge should be completed as soon as possible so as to maintain the safety of the bridge and that this matter constitutes an emergency which is necessary for the preservation of the public's health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The legislative authority of the City of Jackson hereby authorizes the Mayor or Director of Service and Public Safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio to accept the proposal for engineering services of CT Consultants in an amount not to exceed \$171,000.00.

Section 2. This matter is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio in order to maintain the safety of the Harding Avenue bridge.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, wherein meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
