ORDINANCE NO. 45 -12

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A WAGE INCREASE FOR THE POSITIONS OF CHIEF OF POLICE AND ASSISTANT CHIEF OF POLICE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1: The legislative authority of the City of Jackson, Ohio hereby authorizes a wage increase of 2% for the positions of Chief of Police and Assistant Chief of Police as follows:

<u>POSITION</u>	<u>2012 INCREASE</u>	<u>NEW HOURLY RATE</u>
Chief of Police	\$0.45	\$22.88
Asst. Chief of Police	\$0.42	\$21.63

<u>POSITION</u>	<u>2013 INCREASE</u>	<u>NEW HOURLY RATE</u>
Chief of Police	\$0.46	\$23.34
Asst. Chief of Police	\$0.43	\$22.07

The wage rates set forth above shall be effective upon the effective date of this Ordinance. In addition to their base rate of pay, the Chief of Police and the Assistant Chief of Police shall also receive similar pay increases provided to other City employees with the City's Police Department.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Jackson, Ohio in that it is necessary to implement the wage increases as soon as possible. Therefore, this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section 3. In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions were in a meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
