**ORDINANCE NO. 34-13**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSON TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS FOR THE PURCHASE OF VISUAL INTELLIGENCE PORTFOLIO (VIP) SOFTWARE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,254.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City is in need of an upgrade of its accounting and payroll software as the current software is now ten years old and will soon no longer be supported; and

WHEREAS, the City's software provider, Software Solutions, has issued a quote for the upgrade of the City's current accounting and payroll system at a cost of \$40,254 to be paid from the General Fund: Auditor's Office: IT Expense: 110-7715-54008; and

WHEREAS, this matter constitutes an emergency as up-to-date and supported software is necessary to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the City and its citizens and the quoted price is only available until September 15, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON THAT THE SERVICE DIRECTOR OF THE CITY IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT WITH SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS FOR THE PURCHASE OF VISUAL INTELLIGENCE PORTFOLIO (VIP) SOFTWARE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,254.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that the deliberations of the council and any of its committees resulted in such formal action, were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
